Training for the Operations and Maintenance team started February and will continue through May.

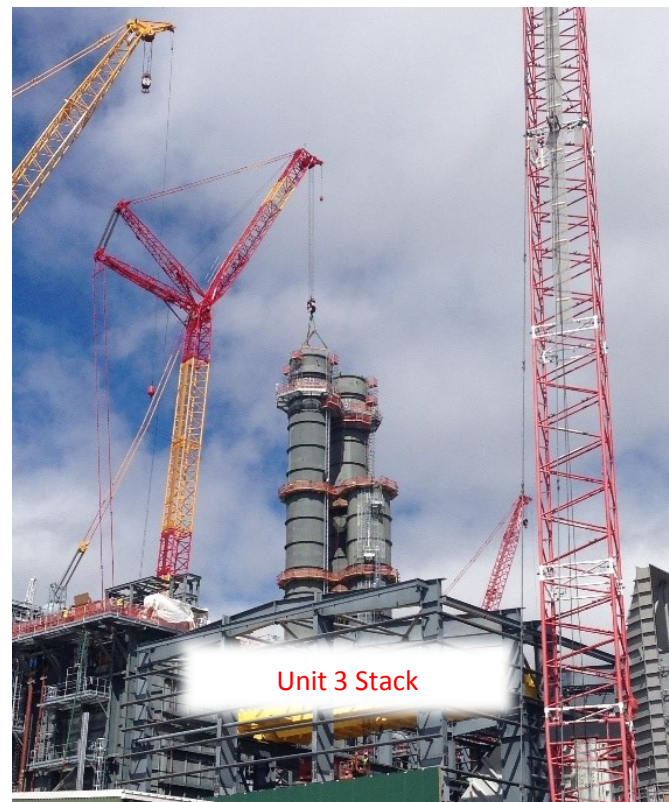
Training on Site for ConEd operators started in March and will go to May when they will begin operating the GIS.

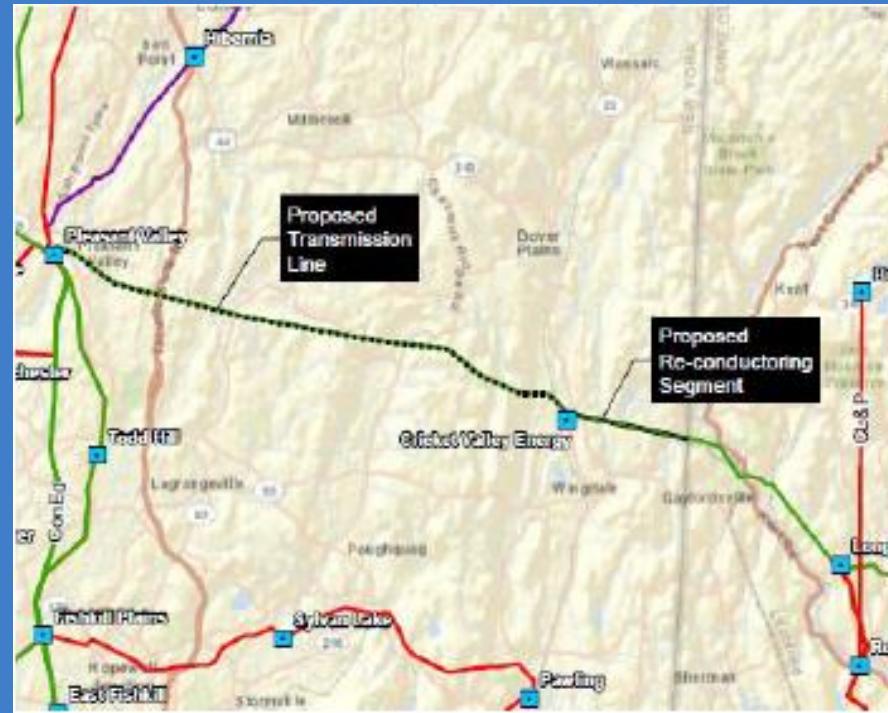
